

Cleaning instruction for Eternit Garden and Design products

Pollution

Products which are affected by algal growth or white efflorescence

Cleaning products

You can use white vinegar (9.5%) or a strong lime scale remover (e.g. Durgol Forte).

For cleaning, it can be used a soft hand scrubbing brush.

To avoid damaging the material industrial cleaning products and do not use a pressure-washer

To avoid damaging the material, the use of high-pressure or industrial cleaners should be avoided during cleaning.

Cleaning

Gently scrub algae / efflorescence with vinegar diluted to not more than 9.5% or strong limescale cleaner diluted according to manufacturers' instructions, then rinse very well with cold water. Do not allow vinegar to come into contact with any bare metal fixings. Avoid cleaning on a hot or sunny day as this may allow the cleaning agents to dry on the surface before they are rinsed off.

For 'raw' grey products, note that white efflorescence is natural, resulting from the cement that forms part of the composite material. Cleaning it off with acidic cleaning agents may leave the surface rather patchy, so it is best to leave grey products to age naturally over time and with exposure to the elements.

Heavy contamination

Should this cleaning not be effective, refer to a specialist cleaning company for further treatment.

Safety

All Eternit (Schweiz) AG garden and design products have been asbestos-free since 1984.

Older products which do contain asbestos do not need to be cleaned at all.
